




Who am I?


Born in South Africa
















How to position yourself as an expert? 1. Personal Branding

Write expert blog posts on your website and share these to your social media	
Post often on social media about current topics Share interesting industry related links on social media

Use your existing email database to share blogs, news and content

3. Building Credibility: PR and The Media	
Research media that your target audience uses:	
 Contact the journalist or editor about submitting expert guest content or exclusive articles 	
Articles must be fresh content and not be published elsewhere	
Include a paragraph bio at the end of your article	
Send a high res head shot or two (portrait and landscape) to the journalist	

- Share the link when it's published in the media
- Your SEO will also organically be boosted by the back link to your site
