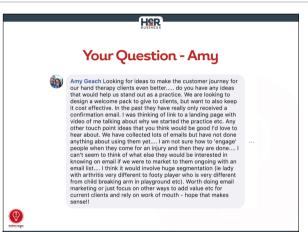

Question 1

- Same as last year is fine
- · People forget
- · Repetition OK
- Can "spruce it up" with new images, a different subject line (split test against last year), perhaps a few copy tweaks or customer story references updated

Question 2

If I am adding in testimonials as well from last year, where abouts should they go - in the middle, at the end....?

- Can you build it into the story? eg "like Julie Smith who attended last year..."
- Web page (REACH web page began as the SPARTA email copy)
- · Use the P.S.

Question 3

If I am sending it out more than once, what should the subsequent emails look like - do I assume they read the first SPARTA email and therefore do a shortened version, OR assume they haven't and repeat the same content?

- Re-send to unopens (with a different subject line)
- "Fwd" the email with a short note at the top to all nonapplicants/non clickers "Just making sure you saw this note"
- Add the full copy to a web page with application (or incorporate into video script) and then send teaser emails





SPARTA

- Try different copy approaches eg
- FAQ
- Short Curiosity
- · Pain Island
- Pleasure Island
- Case Study
- · Urgency / Scarcity
- Bonus focused
- 4 Buyer Types (Spontaneous / Methodical / Humanistic / Competitive)

Question 4

Do I then put the SPARTA email content on my website landing page for the retreat as well or make this a shortened version because the email CTA takes them to the landing page anyway?? (thinking of someone who might not get the SPARTA email and come to the website via FB for example, versus someone who has come to landing page from email and has just read all that content only to be faced with it again on the landing page????)

 Add the full copy to a web page with application (or incorporate into video script)



• Have CTA above the fold



SPARTA

- Use design to break it up / have multiple CTAs throughout / use images and subheadings and section breaks
- Add FAQs
- · Consistency with the FB ads
- · OK to repeat on the landing page

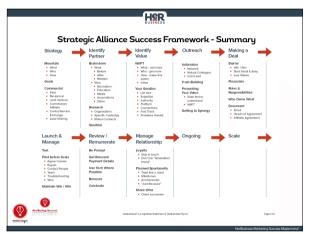

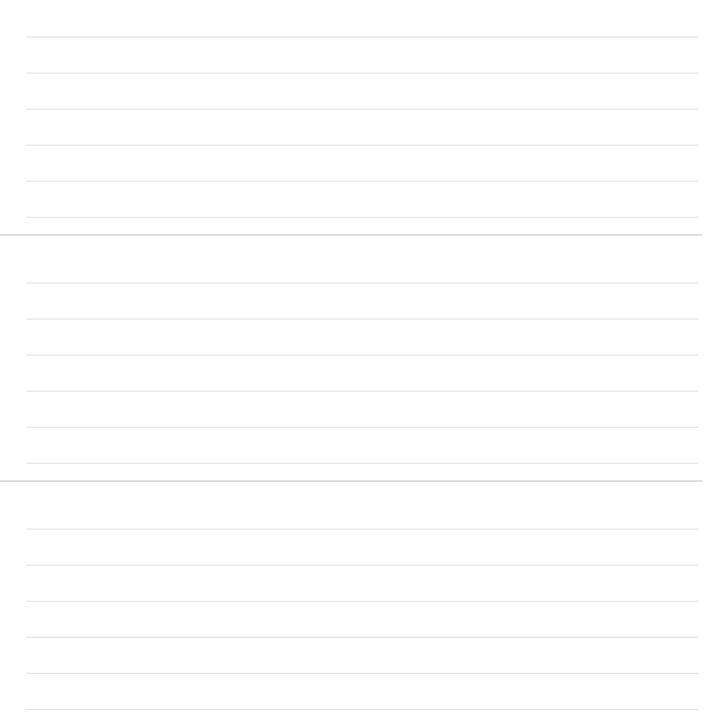


Your Question - Tracey
