- 1. Hyper Responders sort longest, most engaged responses
- 2. Themes find common themes
- 3. Objections find big objections
- 4. Copy create copy eg headlines, bullets (transform the challenge/pain into a benefit statement)
- 5. Inclusions / Bonus do you need to add something to your offer or your bonuses or describe your bonuses in a different way?
- 6. Risk Reversal what might you need to change to reduce risk?
- 7. Stories what client stories do you have that match some of these big themes and objections?

#### **Getting More Engagement**

- Add as events in the Group and invite members
- · Change out the cover image (they get notified)
- Post each morning what is coming up that day
- ${\boldsymbol \cdot}$  Use Units/Guides to add handouts and links so that they can easily find the content
- Add engagement posts



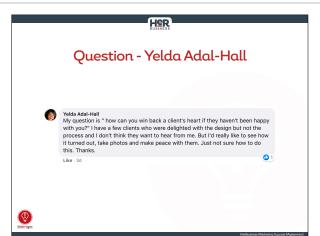

# When Cart is Open

- Go LIVE daily during Open Cart
- Bring on members/graduates as hot seats or case studies/interviews
- Make the offer every time you go live
- Find different angles e.g. one of the biggest issues they have OR a round-up, or in response to what you've been seeing in the group
- Reminder emails that you are going live talking about Xyz.





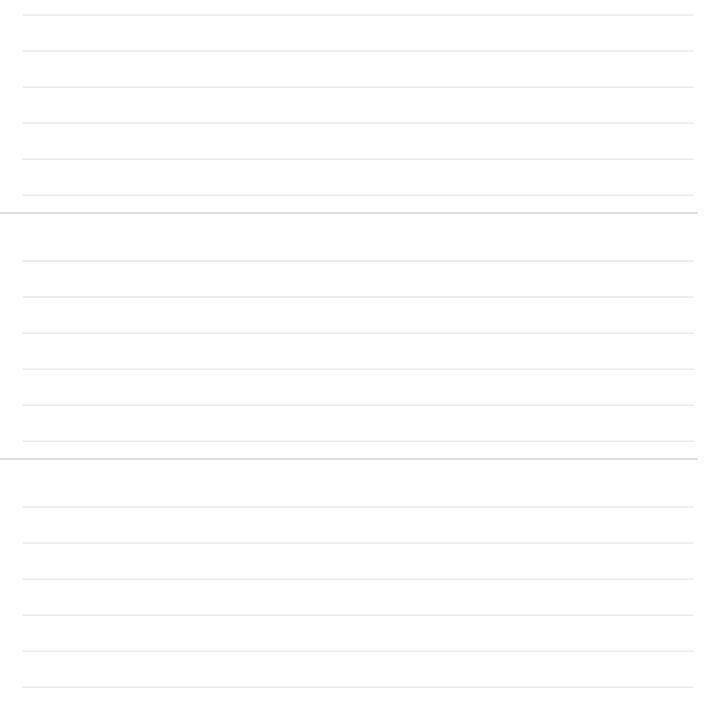




### How to make peace with clients

- Trust your heart and do it anyway send the note, the apology, the photos etc.
- Don't be attached you may not win them back
- · Forgive yourself
- Get your systems in place. Clients (and hearts) are yours to lose.

### Question - Gillian Erskine

- What is your country makeup? What % of people from where? Mostly Nth America or Asia and Europe also?
- What time of day are you hosting? And is there a time that is better suited to everyone? eg 1pm US Central gets most places at a somewhat reasonable hour.
- · Bonus Q&A on different times of day
- Convince people to turn up that it's worth it (don't just assume they won't come)
- Speak to this ahead of time
- · Give tips on best ways to access and make the most of it
- Assumptive close
- Provide timezone details in your marketing and communications and a timezone converter link

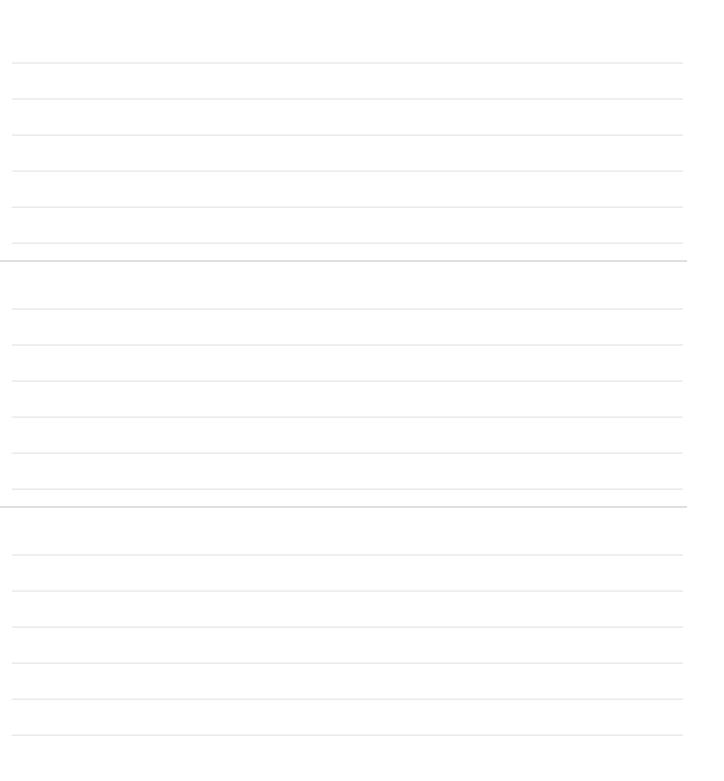

### Question - Gillian Erskine

- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$  Social proof SHOW people where viewers are tuning in from
- Question at start post in the chat where you are joining us today
- Inclusive question tell us in the chat what is "Good morning" in your native tongue
- Challenges in the group for prizes (that are not timezone dependent eg picture of you in your home city) win a t-shirt or a journal etc
- · Share photos of people from all over in social and emails
- Feature internationals as live case studies and promote this ahead of time
- Acknowledge your international guests and the people staying up late or getting up early







### Question - Amanda Farmer



#### Amanda Farmer

I am currently planning a campaign to UPGRADE my monthly members to annual. Putting my 'campaign thinking' hat on, I am planning this as a week-long email campaign: it will be a limited time only opportunity for long-standing monthly members to take up annual membership and thereby get 2 months free each year. I am only including members who have been with me more than 6 months in this campaign. I'd love your thoughts on topics I can cover in the email copy for this campaign. This will be the first time I have run this campaign (and I think that's probably a talking point in itself!) Some monthly members have been with me for 5 years, so theoretically they should jump at this chance to get a cheaper membership, but I want to knock this one out of the park. It would be a great cash flow boost for me. For guidance, I currently have 107 monthly members who would qualify for this offer. I'd love to convert at least 20% to annual membership



### Question - Amanda Farmer

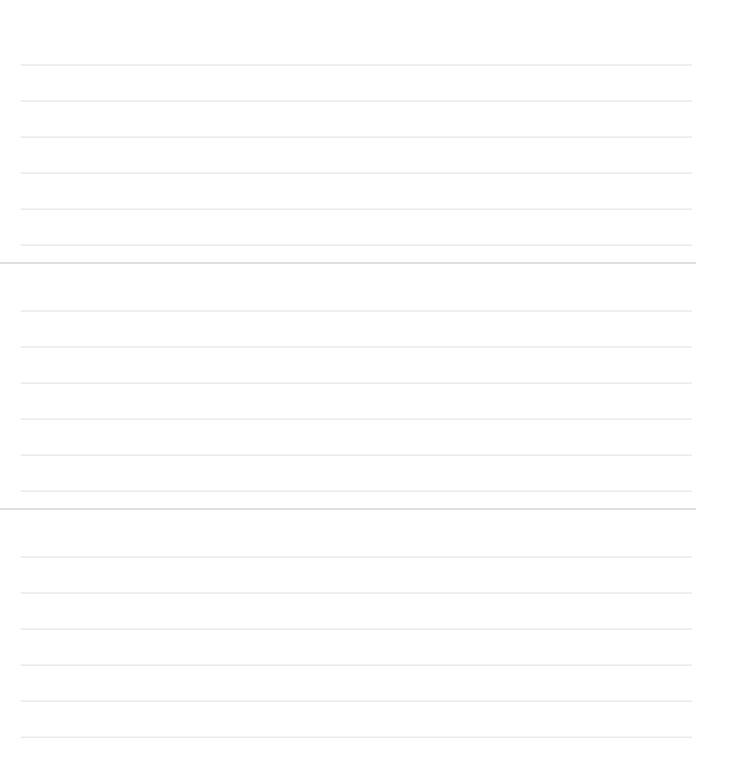
- · Consider an EXTRA perk beyond the 2 months free (does everyone usually get that?)
- Loyalty bonus
- · Apart from cost saving, is there anything that will give them:
- Speed
- Experience · Advisory board?
- · Priority Access?
- Badge / Status inside the membership
- · Do you have a personal story about a time you were rewarded for your loyalty?
- · How can you map this to something else that they might know about eg what else might they be invited to take part in because of their long standing loyalty to



#### Question - Amanda Farmer

- Hook example
- · Bruce Springsteen needed a band
- · Purchasing power
- · Buying Bulk
- · Loyal to me, I feel very loyal to you
- · Admin let's make this easy for both of us. :-)
- · A strong hook will carry you through much of the campaign







# Question - Amanda Farmer

- Quick win now may be harder at renewal time
- Those on monthly may prefer cashflow over savings (and that they can leave)
- How else can you bring in revenue? And how much are you looking to bring in?
- A 2-year membership with extra bonuses is another way if you want to go with this upgrade idea
